## The Bible versus the Qur'an

During this year more questions were asked by Muslims about Jesus' second coming, the signs of the last days and life in the hereafter especially paradise. Although Islam teaches about Jesus being the Word of God, his first and the second coming, it does not present Jesus as the only Savior. For that reason, in our responses we were making it clear in simple words, why Jesus came the first time and His purpose and work at His second coming. This always opened discussions on assurance, eternal life, even about life in paradise. As usual, those who accepted the Lord were put in contacts with other friends in those areas. The numbers of Muslims, who have understood the message of assurance, increased this year but many are hesitant to embrace Him. There has also been an increase on the internet of Islamic polemic attacks against the Christian faith. On one hand Muslim apologists declare the Bible being corrupted yet on the other they quote from it that Muhammad is the promised prophet. It still amazes us how often some Muslims reading the Bible may interpret passages in their own way to suit their Islamic doctrine. Two examples as follows:

1. Quoting Matthew 7:21-23 the interpretation is given that Jesus at his second

coming will deny the Christian doctrine of him being

divine and will reject Christians as his followers.

2. Islamic doctrine in the light of the Qur'an and what Muhammad has said presents paradise as full of heavenly women as a reward for Muslims. To prove that a believer will have many women (or wives) in paradise, some Muslims quote Jesus in Matthew 19:29.

## **Eschatology**

As Christians look to the future, they are looking for the coming of three individuals. The first two are the Antichrist (2 Thess. 2: 1-4) just before the start of the tribulation and his supporter the False Prophet (Rev. 13). At the close of the tribulation Jesus Christ, who is God in the flesh, will return to the earth. Before the tribulation, Jesus returns in the air to remove His church in what is called the Rapture (1 Thess. 4). I am well aware that not all Christians understand the Rapture so I ask you to consider that we are saved "from the wrath that is to come" (1 Thess. 1:10).

It is interesting that Muslims are also looking for three individuals. The first is the Mahdi, who is a religious, political and military leader. Those who take the Bible as the source of truth, find the Mahdi's description parallels that of the Antichrist (Rev. 13; Daniel 11:40-44). The second in importance and supportive of the Mahdi, is the "Prophet Jesus." This is not to be confused with Jesus mentioned in the above paragraph. (Most Muslims are taught that Jesus did not die but was taken to heaven. When he returns he will support the Mahdi including killing Christians and He will eventually marry, have Jews. children and die).

Therefore, please remember that when Christians say that Jesus is returning and a Muslim agrees, they are not talking about the same person. Furthermore, the Muslim description of the "Prophet Jesus" sounds more like the False Prophet of the tribulation. Muslims are taught that the Mahdi and "Prophet Jesus" will seek to control every tongue, nation and tribe, through military force. This sounds similar to what the Bible says about the goals of the Antichrist and False Prophet who are really the front men for the Devil. It is conceivable that during the tribulation, Muslims will follow the Antichrist and False Prophet, thinking they are following the Mahdi and "Prophet Jesus." It seems to me, the names may be changed, but the intent is the same. The third personality is the Dajjal, who is said to be the Antichrist in Islam. He will be discussed later.
