



**Dear Friend of Jesus to Muslims:** The beloved carol O' Holy Night echoes the wonder of the Gospel story (Luke 2:8-14). On that night, God sent Jesus—the eternal Word—into the world as Savior. He is the Father's gracious gift, offered to forgive our sins and restore us to fellowship with Him forever. No wonder the angel proclaimed, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today... a Savior has been born to you; He is the Messiah, the Lord." (Luke 2:10-11)

What many do not realize is that Islam, too, speaks of a sacred night: Laylat al-Qadr, the "Night of Power." Muslims traditionally observe it during the final days of Ramadan, seeking God's mercy, forgiveness, and blessing. Many spend the entire night in prayer—a practice called *ihyā'* ("revival," or "keeping the night alive"). Islamic tradition teaches that the angel Gabriel first approached Muhammad on such a night with the command, "Read! In the name of your Lord who created..." (Sura 96:1).

The Qur'an even contains a short chapter dedicated to this night. One of its verses states: "The angels and the Spirit descend therein, by permission of their Lord, with every decree." (Sura 97:4). Because of this, Muslims believe Laylat al-Qadr is a moment of extraordinary divine attention. Various traditions say, "Whoever prays during the Night of Power with faith and seeking its reward will have his past sins forgiven." (Sahih Bukhari, Vol. 3, Book 31, No. 125). Some also believe that on this night God draws near—either listening directly or through Gabriel—to the requests of those who cry out to Him.

Yet even with these hopeful beliefs, many Muslims still live with uncertainty about God's mercy, forgiveness, and salvation. Their hope rests on a single night each year—and on whether their works might be accepted.

How different, and how wondrous, is the message of the Gospel. Centuries before Muhammad, God had already acted decisively. The Living Word Himself—Jesus Christ—entered human history once for all. The One who is hidden (*al-Bāṭin*) made Himself known (*az-Zāhir*) as grace (*faḍl*) and mercy (*rahma*), not merely through written Words, but by becoming flesh, dwelling among us, and giving His life for our Redemption. The love of God was so great that He knew no man could fulfill the Law of Moses, so He sent Jesus, the perfect Lamb of God, to fulfill that law and restore our personal relationship with God, as Adam had.

While Muslims so devotedly try to fulfill the *Shari'a* (Islamic law, a man-made interpretation of the Law of Moses) to earn their way to paradise, Jesus already did it for them. Muhammad said in the Hadiths that even his own works were not going to save him, except the Grace & Mercy of God on Judgement Day! Believing in Jesus is our Grace, Mercy, and Forgiveness from God.

Muslims have infiltrated this nation with their antichrist spirit, but they are blind to the truth and have no assurance. The harvest of Muslims is great, but the laborers are so few! Won't you join us, as laborers today, to love your Muslim neighbor as yourself enough to bring them the gospel, before the end comes?

We desire to help seekers understand the realities of Islam while encouraging the Ecclesia to love Muslims well and to be equipped to share with them the Good News—the assurance that only Jesus can give.

Your prayers, kindness, encouragement, and generosity have been vital in opening hearts across the USA and throughout the Muslim world to the hope found in Christ Jesus alone.
