

Dear Friend of Jesus to Muslims: In recent years, much has been said in Western media about Sharia law. Some discussions are thoughtful; others fuel fear, suspicion, and anger. Christians are often told to be concerned about Islam's growing influence and the commitment many Muslims have to observing God's law.

While there are legitimate questions about any religious system, Christians should remember that fear rarely opens doors to the Gospel. Instead of reacting with anxiety, we can view this as an opportunity to have meaningful conversations with our Muslim neighbors.

Many Muslims sincerely seek to obey God. Their commitment to prayer, fasting, charity, and moral conduct often reflects a genuine desire to please Him. The Christian response should be one of compassion and understanding, not hostility.

When speaking with Muslim friends, it can be helpful to remember that the concept of divine law predates Islam. Long before *Shari'a*, God gave His Law through Moses. The Torah revealed God's holiness, justice, and righteous standards. Yet Israel's history demonstrates a profound truth: law alone cannot change the human heart.

The Law reveals God's will, but it also reveals humanity's inability to obey Him perfectly. It shows us our need for forgiveness, mercy, and redemption.

This is where the Gospel brings good news.

The Bible tells us that "the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ" (John 1:17). Jesus did not abolish God's law; He fulfilled it. He lived the perfect life that none of us could. Through His death and resurrection, He satisfied God's justice and opened the way for God's mercy to be offered freely to sinners.

The Christian message is therefore not merely "Try harder to obey." It is "Come to the One who has fulfilled God's righteous requirements on your behalf."

Many Muslims hope that, through God's mercy and their good deeds, they may one day enter Paradise. Yet uncertainty often lingers. Have I done enough? Will my good deeds outweigh my bad deeds? Will God accept me?

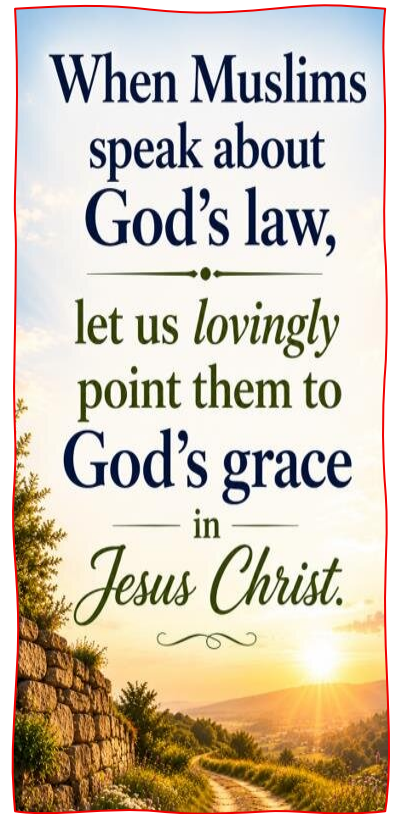
The Gospel offers something remarkable: assurance.

Jesus spoke with an authority unmatched by any prophet. He declared, "I know where I came from and where I am going" (John 8:14). He said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6). He promised, "Whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (John 3:16).

The Christian's confidence rests not on personal merit but on the finished work of Christ. Eternal life is not a possibility to be achieved; it is a gift to be received by faith.

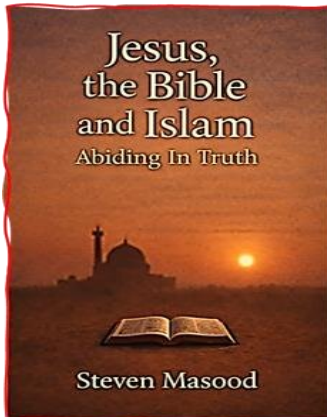
Therefore, when conversations about *Shari'a* arise, let us not respond with fear or anger. Instead, let us point people to the One who fulfilled the Law, demonstrated God's justice, revealed God's mercy, and offers assurance of eternal life.

Our Muslim neighbors do not merely need another discussion of the law. They need to hear about the grace of God revealed in Jesus Christ. When we see zeal for *Shari'a*, let it remind us to share the One who fulfilled the Law and offers grace, mercy, and assurance to all who believe. – **Steven and Karen Masood**

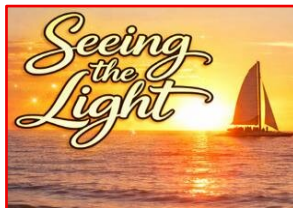

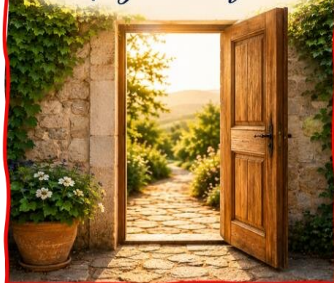

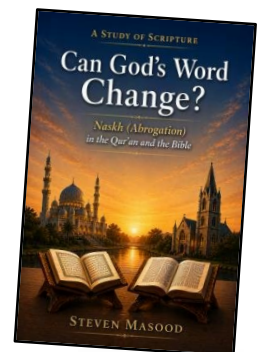


Ministry Snapshot:
