

The Unintended Result of Muslim Extremists: People turning to Christ

They realize that Islamic groups, playing the “religious card” in the name of Islam, cause destruction and conveniently blame the West, as the cause for every problem in their countries.

Amidst all the killing and destruction and fleeing, there are Muslims who want to find meaning to life just as I did. When they see Christ’s faithful followers coming to their aid, they are challenged by the love Jesus presents them through His people.

We at *Jesus to Muslims* have always recognized that when a Christian follows Jesus, he becomes more loving towards Non-Christians. In contrast, when a Muslim imitates the Qur’an and the example of Muhammad, he becomes violent towards Non-Muslims. His aim becomes to submit others to Islam, even if it takes coercion.

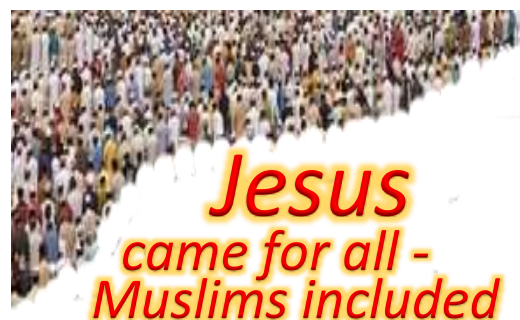

The light of Jesus shines brighter in such darkness. For example, during Khomeini’s Islamic revolution, many Shia Muslims left Iran for Europe and North America. A great number of them have accepted Jesus as their Savior in Iran in spite of persecution.

God is at work in gathering His people around the world who open their hearts to accept Him as Lord and Savior! Indeed, while the media generally advertises atrocities, Christians use media outlets to share the Good News.

The next time you check the news, be reminded that the Lord is still on His throne. Because of His mercy, He gives an extended time to humanity to return to Him. One day, that duration will run out and He will establish His Kingdom – the new heaven and the new earth, as the Scriptures promise.

Until then, ask God to lead you and all of us through His Holy Spirit. Pray for Muslims to come to Christ. Pray for God to show you your part. 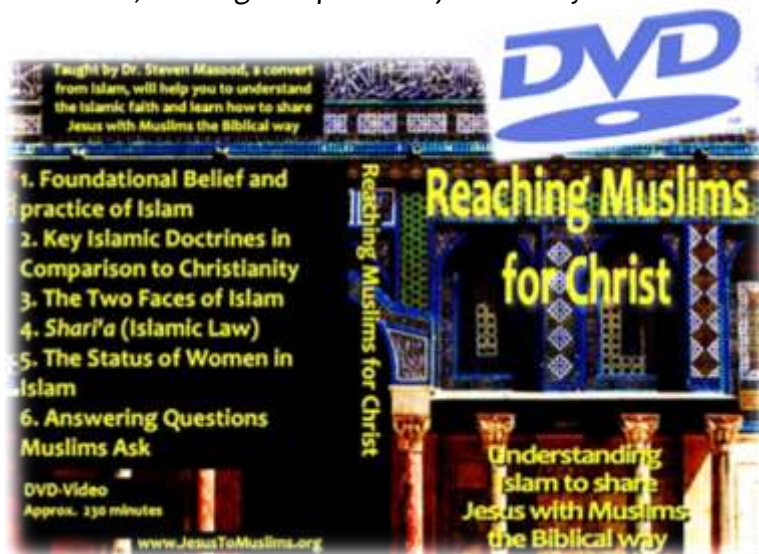
Muslims are no longer far away, a distant people. In the United States today, as in all Western countries, there are growing Muslim communities according to some up to 20 million.
