

Dear Friend of Jesus to Muslims: In many parts of the world, particularly in areas where access to the Bible is limited, there are increasing reports of Muslims experiencing encounters with Jesus through dreams and visions. These accounts have been documented in regions such as North Africa, the Middle East, South Asia, Iran, and others. Although each story is unique, several common patterns tend to emerge among them.

What Do People Report?

Many, including my niece, describe seeing a man in white, radiating peace and authority, who speaks words such as: “I am the one whom you call *Isa al-Masih Ibn Maryam*.” (Jesus the Messiah, the Son of Mary); “I am the way,” “Follow me.” “I am the one who came to set you free”. “I am alive”. “Believe in me”. Sadly, my niece and her husband were martyred for their faith in 2015.

Often, the dream does not give full teaching but creates a deep desire to know more. In numerous cases, the person then seeks out a Bible, meets a Christian, or begins asking questions about Jesus.

Why Is This Important? For many Muslims, Jesus is already respected as a prophet. In these reported dreams, He is often shown not just as a prophet, but as someone who:

- Knows the individual personally
- Calls them to Himself
- Offers peace and assurance

This represents a turning point—from believing Jesus is the Word and Spirit of God to understanding that He offers salvation and eternal life to all who believe.

How Should Christians Respond? Christians should approach such accounts with both openness and care:

1. Rejoice in God’s initiative: God can reach people in ways beyond our expectations. A dream may be the beginning of a spiritual journey. Joseph had dreams and even interpreted a dream for Pharaoh.

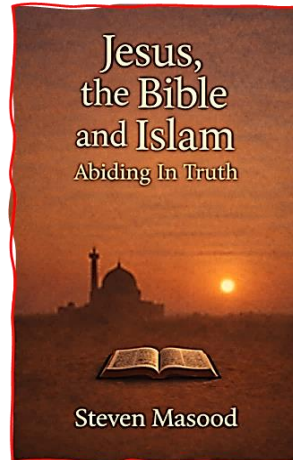
2. Point to Scripture: A dream is not the final message — it is an invitation. The person must be guided to the Bible, where the life and teaching of Jesus are clearly revealed, and must be willing to follow it.

3. Avoid exaggeration: Not every story is accurate or verifiable. We must be careful not to build our faith on reports that do not align with God’s Word.

4. Emphasize the Gospel: The goal is not the experience itself, but a true understanding of who Jesus is—His life, His death, and His resurrection.

A Biblical Perspective The Bible shows that God can use dreams to draw people; for example, Joseph was guided by dreams (Matthew 1–2). Paul the Apostle was directed by a vision to Macedonia (Acts 16:9). At the same time, Scripture consistently directs people beyond the experience to God’s revealed truth.

A Gentle Reminder
Dreams and visions may awaken interest—but they do not replace the Gospel. True faith is not built on what we see in the night, but on what God has spoken clearly in His Word.

Reflection and Encounter

Talking with Muslim friends can lead to meaningful discussions. For instance, ask: "If God spoke to you in a dream, what would He say?" This often leads to discussions about Jesus, who provides hope and assurance. I asked someone who didn't believe in the God of the Bible why they didn't pray to Him directly, and she did. Then in her dream, she saw Jesus as the high priest, interceding for people. Surprisingly, she had never read the Old Testament and didn't know about the priest's attire, including the jeweled breastplate, yet she envisioned Him this way. – **Steven and Karen Masood**

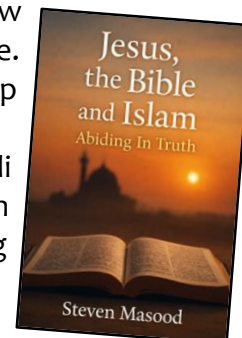
Prayer and praise points:
