



Christianity or Christ?

God has revealed Himself uniquely in Jesus Christ.

If we compare one religion with another, Christianity has little to commend itself. Like every human institution, its history includes both faithfulness and failure—wars, divisions, hypocrisy, greed, and people who acted in Christ's name while ignoring His teachings. Christians readily admit we have often fallen short of our Lord's example.

So, if my Muslim friends ask whether Christianity is simply a "better religion," my answer is: "That is not the heart of the Christian message."

The Person of Jesus Christ

The Christian faith does not stand or fall on the achievements of its followers. It stands or falls on the person of Jesus Christ.

Jesus is unlike any other religious leader. He did not merely point to the way—He declared, "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6). He did not simply teach God's Word—He is called "the Word" who became flesh and dwelt among us (John 1:1, 14). He did not merely offer guidance—He gave His life as a sacrifice for our sins and rose again so that all who trust in Him may receive eternal life.

From Religion to Relationship

This is why the comparison matters. During the years I was a Muslim searching for God, I prayed the opening chapter of the Qur'an each day, asking God to "guide us to the Straight Way." Looking back, I came to understand that the answer to that sincere prayer was not found in another religion, but in a Person. Jesus Christ is the Way I had been searching for.

When speaking with Muslims, therefore, I do not try to persuade them that Christianity is a superior religion. Rather, I invite them to meet the One who is altogether unique.

Religions change as humanity changes. Jesus Christ, however, is constant—the same yesterday, today, and forever (Hebrews 13:8). Our invitation, then, is not merely to accept Christianity, but to come personally to Christ Himself. — **Steven and Karen Masood**

At first glance, the question may sound reasonable. Yet I believe it begins with the wrong comparison. The Christian message is not that one religious system has outperformed another, but that

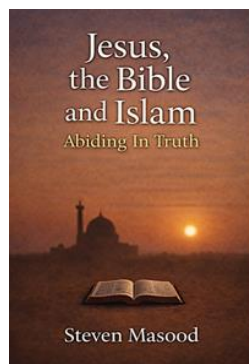
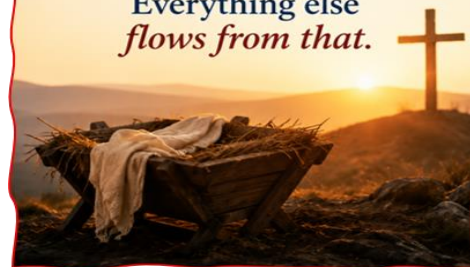

- ❖ We are grateful for your support. Your involvement provides biblical resources to seekers and strengthens new followers of Christ.

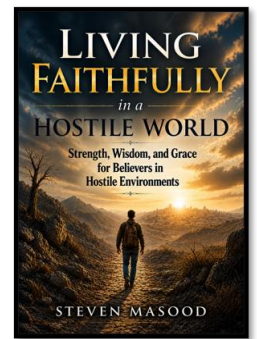
Prayer and praise points: Pray for Muslim hearts to be opened to truth and for protection for new believers.
