The USA was founded under God Almighty's laws. The Pilgrims who were freed by fleeing (Matthew 10:23) from the tyranny of King James in England learned that the government of Christ begins in the heart of the individual. True religious liberty can only be built upon the genuine practice of self-government. In other words, every man is accountable to the One True God. In England, the powers that be were in this order: God, the king, and then the people. The new order of rule for our nation under the Mayflower Compact established in 1606 is God, the people, and then the government (the king). The reason is simple: Self-government, by its very nature, yields **PEACE** with everyone living in safety – "every man under his vine and his fig tree" (I Kings 4:25). See *The Founders' Bible* by David Barton, p. 186.

This form of rule in the USA allowed me the free choice to follow Christ in a country with the freedom to choose my own religion. Prior to choosing Christ, I was free to choose no religion at all. I chose the religion this nation was founded on because I needed Christ's unconditional love. Eventually, I learned that Christianity is not just a religion but is truly a relationship with the loving and just God! No other religion offers this beautiful relationship. As Christians, we know the only answer for people to enter Paradise is through Christ. By their own God-given free will, they can choose the Truth of God's Word or reject Him.

A Common Word: It has come to my attention that "Christian leaders" responded to a Muslim open letter titled, "A Common Word" with a public reply contrary to God's Word and obviously it has now been several years, many of them still uphold the Muslim document and shake hands with Muslims in an unbiblical way of compassion and love. They do not understand Islam and need to be equipped on Islam to "know our enemy" before entering into such contexts and dialogue. I must address this grave concern because Jesus Christ teaches that if I see my brother stumble/sin, I need to point it out for the benefit of the Church (Matthew 18:15-17). Since I cannot meet with them in person, I am addressing the issue in this newsletter, which goes to the body of Christ that desires to be equipped in order to reach Muslims with the Gospel. A Peace initiative? I submit to you that these responders from Yale in their response titled as 'Loving God and Neighbor Together' have not used spiritual discernment, but rather used human understanding. The PEACE of God is beyond human understanding (Philippians. 4:7). I Corinthians 2:14 says, "But the natural man receives not the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness unto him; neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned." Isaiah 55:8-9 clearly expresses that the LORD'S thoughts and

ways are higher than ours. I Corinthians 1:19-29 teaches the important truth of how God made foolish the wisdom of this world, destroying the "wisdom of the wise" because "God was pleased through the

foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe... God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. He chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things--and the things that are not--to nullify the things that are, so that no one may boast before him."

The signing of the response to "A Common Word" shows me that these 'Christian' prominent leaders have been lulled to sleep by our enemy, Satan. Yes, Satan is prowling around like a roaring lion looking to devour us (1 Peter 5:8-9). Therefore, we all must be on guard for our enemy and resist him, not allowing ourselves to be lulled into complacency for our destruction. Biblically speaking, whoever does not choose Christ and God's free gift of eternal life through Him chooses by default to follow Satan to the place God created for him and all his followers: Hell (Matthew 25:41). God is clearly righteous and just. A young boy who was baptized Sunday said it best, "If you don't choose Jesus, you're not going to Heaven!" Out of the mouth of babes! Jesus said that unless we change and become like little children, we will not enter the Kingdom of God (Matthew 18:3).

The One and Only God

I have learned from my last nine years of study under my husband, who is a scholar of both Islam and Christianity, that the one and only God Christians follow is not the same god that Muslims follow. While there are some words in common in Christian dialogue with Muslims and the terms may sound the same, the Islamic dictionary has entirely different meanings. How cunning the enemy is! This is how the Great Deceiver operates, disguising himself as "an angel of light" (2 Corinthians 11:13-15).

For instance, in using the common word GOD, we find today that Satan has deceived so many people with different meanings of God. Be informed that Allah is Arabic for god. There is no other Arabic term for god. Muslims may give you the impression that your God's name is Allah but that is not true. Let us compare the god of Islam and the One and Only God, the God of Christianity:

- 1. The god of Islam is aloof doesn't much care about people.
- 2. Islam's god does whatever he wants and changes his mind for whatever reason.
- 3. Muhammad's god is not relational at all; such a concept is blasphemous to a Muslim.

- That the Lord will bring more partners needed in outreach to Muslims & more appts.
- We need an administrator with a passion for our mission to look after day to day appointments and organization. For example: to send follow-up letters before and after our speaking appointments; to organize office with easy access filing system; to use our database (Servant Keeper etc.) efficiently. Please pray with us that the Lord will bring that person our way.

- 4. The god of Islam will not be in paradise with a person who achieves this paradise through works; he is anywhere else except with a mere human being.
- 5. This god of Islam cannot and has not begotten anyone; he has no Son.
- 6. The god of Islam is not our Father in Heaven.
- 7. The god of Islam is not Triune and therefore is not equal to Jesus or the Holy Spirit. Tawhid means the unity of god, which Muslim state as "Allah is one and Muhammad is his prophet."

Does any of the above sound like the same God as our God, the God of the Christians? Absolutely not!

- 1. The Christian God first loved every human being and created mankind for relationship with Him.
- 2. God never changes, and is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow. His Word is unchanging Truth.
- 3. God created man in His own image to be eternal living beings in relationship with Him forever.
- 4. The Christian God dwells with His people at all times and always will, even in Heaven forever.
- 5. Our Creator Father God loves us so much that He sacrificed His only begotten Son as the perfect sacrifice for us, His adopted children. He restored the relationship we had before Adam and Eve's sin. After Jesus paid the cost for our sins and victoriously resurrected from the dead, God sent the Holy Spirit to dwell with us always, to keep His promise to be with us to the ends of the earth!
- 6. God is our perfect Father who knows what is best for us. Through faith in Christ, we are adopted into His family as His children.
- 7. The true God our Creator is Triune One in three persons: the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit. God is omniscient, omnipresent, omnipotent, loving, and just. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life –the only way to the Father (John 14:6).

I am sure you already understand from just this much information that Muslims and Christians do NOT worship the same One God. Sadly, many "Christians" do not truly know God. In order to get on the same page with the people with whom we are talking, we must ask them first what they mean by God. When

having one-on-one dialogue with a Muslim, it is important to ask the appropriate questions to every person with whom we are sharing Christ, to find out their own understanding of God.

The Bible is God's Word that can never be changed, replete with everlasting promises that are true. In Matthew 24, Jesus gives signs of the end of the age. He says, "For false messiahs and false prophets will appear and perform great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect." The Muslim clerics who wrote "A Common Word" even noted that they believe that Jesus was a Prophet and the Messiah, yet they deny Jesus being the Son of God. According to the Scriptures, denying the Father and the Son is the spirit of the Antichrist (1 John 2:18-23).

Love of Neighbor: How does one love their neighbor as themselves if they don't love themselves?

Have you ever gotten into an argument with someone who does not believe the same thing you do? I am sure most of us have. Have you ever truly analyzed what went wrong? I grew up in a hostile household in which my parents didn't go to church but simply dropped us kids off for a free babysitting service. As we all know, God uses everything that Satan meant for evil and turns it to be used for His good (Romans 8:28). Low and behold, at youth group I learned that Jesus could wipe my sins away, tossing them as far as the east is from the west and remembering them no more! I accepted Christ as my Savior; I repented of my sin and turned away from it, never to do that again.
