long time before colonialism and the crusades, in 622 AD when Muhammad established a Muslim community, *Ummah*. Since then, people of other faith, Jews and Christians in the Middle East, Zoroastrians and Hindus and Buddhists in South East Asia have been the target. We may surely remember Hitler killing so many Jews, but do you know that more Christians and Jews were killed in the 20th century, in Muslim majority lands by Muslims than anywhere else by enemies, because of their faith.

What is the Truth?

Pilate's words are still repeated by many in the world, sometime even ignoring the reply. Christians in the Muslim world, although entitled in some countries to equality of citizenship and religious freedom, are still losing those rights with their lives. Inter-religious and inter-communal tensions and conflicts from Nigeria, Egypt and Sudan, to Iraq, Afghanistan, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Malaysia and Indonesia have raised major concerns about deteriorating rights and security for Christian minorities in Muslim countries. Conflicts have varied, from acts of discrimination, to forms of violence escalating to murder, and the destruction of villages and churches. Even mosques have been destroyed, if it was seen that a particular group of Muslims were not really 'Muslims'.

In one of my conversations on chat-lines with Muslim friends, I was quite surprised when a group of Muslims put the blame of such a situation on the 21st century western notion of "tolerance" and "co-existence". According to them this effort of people of the West was pushing them to a higher level of

religious pluralism, which the Qur'an, the traditions of Islam and Islamic law rejects. In their opinion the freedom that is available to the West that anyone can say what he likes, believes and is even free to insult and blaspheme another's faith and practice with degrading words is too much for Muslims in the East. Thus, they become violent to their neighbors so that people in the West will stop demeaning Islam.

Another reason for the riots and strikes was that the West refuses to give up being in the lead.

Muslims from the East have the minds and the resources now to be the leaders over all nations, but the West is not giving them a chance.

What should a Christian do?

First of all, as believers we have to understand that we are in this world but not of this world. Face the facts. We cannot fix the problem, only God can. However, he has shown us in the Scriptures that it is going to be troubled times. We can ease the pain, but will not be able to remove it all. We should use all means available to stand for the truth, as Jesus stood in every walk of our life. We should share the law of 'grace', 'mercy' and 'assurance' of a life, available through Jesus, beyond all this turmoil in the world, to our neighbors, whether Muslims or non-Muslims, Christians or non-Christians. Instead of teaming up with socalled movements with slogans of co-exist and inclusivism, we should be practical in our outreach. Let us not just Band-Aid the ideologies of the world but present an alternative that is available through Christ and leave the result to God. We must please God over man!
