Is Jesus God with us?

"Do not be afraid, Mary; you have found favor with God. You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High" (Luke 1:30-32).



Dear Friend in Jesus! My Muslim friend and I had a lively discussion on the person of Jesus via Skype. We were discussing how God who is 'al-Batin' – hidden, became 'az-Zahir' – revealed to dwell among people. My Muslim friend was surprised that not just once, but twice the angel Gabriel mentioned the divinity of Jesus. In verse 35 of the same chapter in Luke the angel responds to Mary: "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So, the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God."



My friend's brother was listening and barged in with repeating Arabic words 'Na'udhu billah' – God forbid; 'Kufr' – Blasphemy. He was claiming that Jesus will come back as a follower of Muhammad. He will deny his divinity and follow Islamic law. He went on to claim that on his return Jesus will say to Christians, "I do not know you" ... '... why ...

because you call him Lord. He is not ... You made Him God ... that is the reason He will deny you.'

To support his argument, he quoted Matthew 7:22-23 insisting that Jesus will be upset on His return because he is called 'Lord' by Christians. I asked him to read the verse before and after stating that the context is not about the Lordship of Jesus but of not obeying what Jesus commanded (Matthew 7:21 - 24).

What a surprise? One brother was a listener and the other was so disruptive that he disconnected the line. To influence and win an argument many today quote the Bible out of context and ignore evidence that may contradict their claim. In this case, it is not just in Matthew, but also in Luke and John that a similar matter is presented. In Luke Jesus says, "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?" (Luke 6:46). In fact in John it becomes clearer. Jesus said, "You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am." (John 13:13). So it is obvious that Jesus is not rejecting his own Lordship or divinity, but in fact is questioning the obedience of the followers.

Dear friends, even Satan knows the Bible. He used it out of context against Jesus and is even busy doing the same today. Let's study the Scriptures in its whole context – celebrating Jesus as Immanuel, God

with us, and also sharing Him with others so they might also know Him.
