

Radical Muslims versus Radical Christians

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Dear Friend of Jesus to Muslims! When I teach seminars on a Biblical approach to Islam, often someone will comment that as there are radical Muslims, there are radical Christians, too, who have been terrorizing others, and therefore, we should not label all Muslims.

Like many words and terms, "fundamentalist" and "radicals" are often taken out of context by the modern media. If it

is true that there are Christians who are terrorizing others, then they are not really following the teachings of Jesus, but are merely calling themselves Christians. Often, we are told that as there are 'wishy washy' Christians, there are 'wishy washy' Muslims and as there are moderate Muslims, there are moderate Christians. Such terms are not Biblical nor Qur'anic, it is impossible to believe in moderation and practice in moderation. One is fully in or fully out. Let me explain.

Key Observation: Ideology and the Ideal

"Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you" (Luke 6:27-28) As one coming out of Islam, I have extensively studied, and continue to study, both faiths. I have found some staggering facts. In the Qur'an, believers

in Muhammad are told to fulfill their duties and responsibilities they owe to Allah. For this purpose, when they go back to the Qur'an and examine what Muhammad said and did, they become remarkably "fundamentalist" and "radical," which lead to terrorism. This also leads

to exclusivism in loving and dealing with **only** Muslims of their same school of thought. They become bold not only in sharing their beliefs with others, but they do not hesitate in using "all means" to eliminate what they perceive to be blasphemy. This often includes killing the blasphemer or apostate and non-Muslims.

On the other hand, I see that believers in Jesus are called to live **in** the world, but not to be **of** it. How? They go back again and again to Jesus! They learn from him and his apostles. The Bible shows them how to fulfill the purpose God gave them while living in this broken world. God's Holy Spirit, which Jesus promised, guides them in how to live for God and how to endure persecution.

These believers, like Muslim friends, remarkably become "fundamentalist" and "radical," but in an entirely different way! They become loving, forbearing in their dealings and forgiving because of God's forgiveness and love. At the same time, they are bold enough, in the face of all opposition, to tell the truth in love about Jesus being the only assurance of salvation. They do not threaten the lives of other people, but rather serve and love people for God's glory. Some may point to Crusades in their objection. Let's be reminded that while the Crusades was unbiblical, invasion of non-Muslims and killing is Qur'anic for Muslims.

While Islamic teaching exalts the brotherly love between Muslims only, 'almuslim akhwal muslim' – a Muslim is a brother to a Muslim, Jesus teaches: 'If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? And if you greet only your brothers, what are you doing



more than others? Do not even pagans do that? Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect' (Matthew 5:44-48).

The Qur'anic teaching states that Allah loves those who kill for him, (Sura 61:4) one will not find such a passage in the teaching of Jesus, who commands his followers to, "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you" (Luke 6:27-28).

- Please pray for protection for our ministry's media equipment and our websites. Please pray for protection as we travel in our van, which now has over 243,000 miles on it!
- Pray for Christian friend's protection as we train and mentor them to share the Gospel with Muslims.
 This is clearly a spiritual battle we are in and the enemy does not like us.
- ❖ We praise God for the awareness growing about the truth of Islam and the very real need for outreach to Muslims. Consider only 8 % of churches stand with this calling to reach Muslims.
- We thank God for our supporters, both individuals and church fellowships that enable us to continue to do the work we do, all for God's glory. Please pray for more appointments and financial support.

Other Activities:

We have now recorded and edited 20 programs and offered them for broadcast to the South Asian division of Christian Broadcast Network. We intend to offer them to other Christian networks too, hoping some will come forward and broadcast them free of charge to bring souls to Christ.

We have also started another program on the Internet in Urdu to respond to objections raised in Muslim video presentations about Biblical doctrines. The program is called *Qindil* – the lamp, similar to the word 'candle'. The program varies between 10 to 20 minutes long.

We continue to respond to queries, questions, and objections from Muslims. In addition, we travel to hold seminars and discussions to equip the body of Christ in their outreach to Muslims. We continue to help Muslim background believers in their spiritual journey with Christ through counselling and other means.
